

## MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS FOR CONCRETE PRODUCTS

SMOOTH CONCRETE \* WASHED CONCRETE \* POLISHED CONCRETE \* BRUSHED CONCRETE

- 1. Primarily use water and a hard brush, where possible pressure washer, to remove dirt and other rubbish from the surface of concrete products.
- 2. It is forbidden to use unknown chemicals for cleaning concrete products from dirt.
- 3. If permanent soiling occurs on the concrete products or any other problems arise or you have any questions please contact our production foreman who will come to the location, assess the situation and suggest our solution for resolving the problem based on what he has seen at the location.
- 4. It is strictly forbidden to control snow and ice in winter using salt and unknown chemicals and fertilisers.
- 5. It is explicitly forbidden to remove ice and compacted snow from concrete surfaces with a metal crowbar and similar hammer tools.
- 6. Use a hard brush or broom to remove snow from the surface of concrete products. It is recommended to remove snow at once before it becomes compacted.
- 7. If ice forms on concrete stairs or pavement slabs, we recommend sprinkling crushed granite gravel or sand in places with pedestrian traffic to make these areas less slippery. Gravel and sand can be removed after ice has melted by cleaning the surface with a brush or water (if possible with a pressure washer).
- 8. We recommend impregnating concrete products with concrete sealer to protect concrete surfaces and reduce the effect of dirt and salt.
